- Be able to understand and influence behaviour within groups
- Have developed skills in leading a team
- Understand the role they have to play and the contribution they can make to the team
- Creatively approach the solving of problems and the development of ideas within the team
- Understand what they can do to get the best out of their colleagues and help the team to perform effectively

What the programme involves:

This is a highly interactive event with several team building and team working exercises being utilised. Participants complete self-assessment questionnaires that help them to decide the contribution they have to make to the team.
